**Subject: Annual Plan 2007-08, Arunachal Pradesh—additional allocation of Rs.190.09 crore as grant (Special Plan Assistance) for completion of pending projects under Power and Transport Sector, as a part of Prime Minister's announcement made at Itanagar.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to the Planning Commission's letter of even number dated 25.07.07 conveying approval of Sectoral breakup for the Annual Plan 2007-08 outlay of Rs.1320.00 crore and letter dated 19.2.2008 conveying additional allocation of Rs.20 crore as grant (Special Plan Assistance) for the Annual Plan 2007-08, as a part of Prime Minister's announcement made at Itanagar.

2. Planning Commission further allocates Rs.190.09 crore as grant (Special Plan Assistance) as a part of Prime Minister's announcement made at Itanagar, over and above the onetime ACA/SPA of Rs.212.96 crore( Rs.193.66 crore grant) for the Annual Plan 2007-08 for completion of pending projects under Power and Transport Sector as below:


(The details of projects under Power sector and abstracts of pending projects (roads/bridges under PWD/RWD) are at **annexure-I-IV**.)

3. Planning Commission recommends release of the grant provision of Rs.190.09 crore to the state govt. to be passed on to the implementing agencies. State would make compulsory provision of at least 10% of the available fund for maintenance. The list of works to be taken up with the grant provision would be up loaded in the website for monitoring of progress works on regular basis.

4. Consequent upon the approval of Rs 190.09 crore for the above mentioned scheme, the size of the Annual Plan 2007-08 of Arunachal Pradesh would increase to Rs 1530.09 crore.

5. The increase in the outlay will be utilised by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh only for the purpose for which it is approved and it stands earmarked for the same.
6. The Government of Arunachal Pradesh shall furnish utilization certificates to the Planning Commission upon completion of the projects in the prescribed format by the due date.


